How to Glorify God at School

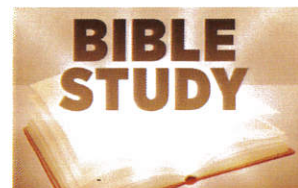
Stewardship - "Everything I have is yours." (Luke 15:31)
